Marriage Preparation

Couples preparing for marriage should contact the rectory at least six months before a proposed wedding date. Please do not set a marriage date before you consult a priest.

Baptism

Parents and godparents are expected to attend a session with one of the parish priests prior to the Baptism to become familiar with the commitments and responsibilities for nurturing children in the Catholic faith.

Letter of Recommendation

A parishioner known by a St. Patrick priest and registered with the parish for three months can receive a letter of recommendation stating their eligibility to become a godparent in a baptism or a sponsor in a confirmation at another parish.

Special Events Volunteers
